Safety

Mishap Reporting and Investigation

CAPR 62-2, 15 September 1999, is supplemented as follows:

Added 4A(1):

Florida Wing Mishap Notification Procedures:

- (a) The unit or activity commander will immediately notify the Wing Commander or their designee by direct voice-to-voice communication when any mishap involving either reportable Body Injury or reportable Property Damage described in Par. 3.

Notify the following as applicable:

Wing Commander: All reportable mishaps.  
Director of Safety: All reportable mishaps.

Contact info is provided in Attachment 1. Since this is a fluid document, changes/updates will occur. Announcements of such will be made.

- (b) Wing Commanders or their designees will, in turn, notify National Headquarters, the Wing Liaison Officer and the Region Commander or their designee by direct voice communications of all mishaps reported to them by the Unit or Activity Commander that involves serious physical injury or substantial property damage as defined in paragraph 830.2 of Part 830, NTSB Title 49 (Attachment 2 of CAPR 62-2E).
