CIVIL AIR PATROL FLIGHT MANAGEMENT

CAP Regulation 70-1, dated 31 March 2020 (ICL 20-08 1 October 2020), is supplemented as follows:

1) This publication establishes Florida Wing (FLWG) standards and procedures related to the control and management of FLWG CAP flying programs, aircraft, and aircrews. This supplement applies to all FLWG CAP units and members.

6.2. Added. Flight Instruction. Flight instruction authorization may be rescinded via memo by the FLWG/CC stating the reason for rescinding the privilege within 7 days of initial notification.

7.1.2. Added. Flight Evaluations. All CAPF 70-5 flight evaluations will be completed with a check pilot different from the CAP instructor who has prepared the pilot unless doing so would cause an unreasonable burden to complete the pilot's evaluation. Approval for waiver to this section is granted by the FLWG/CC or FLWG/DOV.

7.1.5.1 Added. Local Familiarization. Local units are responsible for ensuring visiting or transferring pilots complete a local area orientation and familiarization conducted by a Mission Pilot Evaluator or IP. This local area orientation will be approved by Group DO/DOV.

9.11.2.4.1 Added. Fuel. FLWG/CC or FLWG/DO will establish fueling standards for Florida Wing for all aircraft.

9.11.11.2 Added. Form 18 Compliance. Local units will provide support to FLWG Form 18 verification no later than the 7th of each calendar month.
