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- WHAT:** Florida Wing Cadet Competition
- WHEN:** 06– 08 MAR 2020
- WHERE:** Florida Elks Youth Camp
- WHO:** All FLWG Cadets and Senior Members (SMs)
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EVENT DESCRIPTION:

The Florida Wing Cadet Competition is an annual event in which cadet color guard teams and cadet drill teams compete to represent the Florida Wing at the Southeast Region Cadet Competition. The event consists of many areas of competition, from military drill performances, to athletic challenges to academic evaluation.

ELIGIBILITY:

Cadets

- Must have completed achievement one.
- Must be on the Monthly Membership Listing at the time of the competition.
- Cadets 18 and over must have completed Cadet Protection Policy Training (CPPT).

Senior Members

- Must have completed level one and Cadet Protection Policy Training (CPPT Basic).
- Must be on the Monthly Membership Listing at the time of the competition.

FEE:

Cadets

- \$680 per team/\$85 per member – A team of 6 cadets and 2 Escorts.
- No shows will NOT be afforded a refund.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Team Applications

- Due no later than **25 FEB 2020**.
- Applications should consist of a roster of 6 cadets, 2 Escort and a copy of the transfer request to Wing Banker in the correct amount. Emailed to Maj Risler at jrisler@flwg.us.
- Fully signed CAPF 60-81 Application for special activity
- CAPF 160(I)
- CAPF 161

DEADLINES:

Teams must register & submit FLWG transfer request for the activity fee by **25 FEB 2020**.

SPECTATOR PROCEDURE:

Teams may bring spectators but they are the full responsibility of the team and should be listed on the team roster.

TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation to and from such activity is not the responsibility of CAP and is provided "as available". Privately owned vehicles travel to or from such activity is performed strictly at the member's own risk (reference CAPR 77-1, para 6c and CAPR 60-1, 8.7.8.2.1) and is not under CAP direction and control. Transportation during the activity will NOT be provided.

LODGING INFORMATION:

We are having the FLWG CC at the Florida Elks Youth Camp and cabins / sleeping facilities are included in the event fee and will be assigned during check in.

EVENT LOCATION:

All events will take place in a centralized area and are within walking distance. A detailed map will be provided at sign in.

MEALS:

- **Friday:**
 - No Meals will be provided.
- **Saturday:**
 - Breakfast at the dining facility - included in fee.
 - Lunch at the dining facility - included in fee.
 - Dinner at the dining facility - included in fee.
- **Sunday:**
 - Breakfast at the dining facility - included in fee.
 - Lunch will not be provided.
 - Will finish the event before lunch to get everybody back home early.

UNIFORM: BDUs / ABUs / PTU

- **Friday:** Team shirts (or casual t-shirt of good taste) and blue jeans.
- **Saturday:** Each team will be given a schedule of events at the time of check-in. This schedule of events will be used to determine what uniform will be worn during the event.
- **Sunday:** Short sleeve blue shirt (no tie) with ribbons for the Awards Ceremony.

EQUIPMENT LIST:

Teams should bring all required equipment to perform a competition as stated in the competition guidelines including CAPP 52-4, and CAPR 900-2. Teams will need to bring all their own equipment:

- Rifles
- Flags & Poles
- Stands
- Harnesses
- Belts
- Gloves.

COMPETITION ELECTIVES:

This years' FLWG Cadet Competition electives will concentrate on Panel Quiz and speeches – Community Service.

- Pre Competition Service Project (2 Cadet Team).
- Panel Quiz (4 Cadet Team).

COMPETITION REGULATIONS:

Teams will be judged in accordance with National Cadet Competition Curriculum Guide Pamphlet 52-4, dated February 2015.

For Panel Quiz teams will be judged using CAPM 52-4 dated 20 Mar 2009.

TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES:

The teams are responsible for the following:

- Transportation to / from / during the activity.
- A TEAM sponsor(s) for all cadets, in accordance with the CPPT for overnight CAP activities.
- Follow all CAP regulations.
- Conduct of all members of their team, sponsors and spectators.

CHECK-IN:

- Teams / staff will check in between 1900 hrs. and 2100 hrs. on Friday 06 **MAR 2020** at the designated area.
- Members checking in must be in uniform, as prescribed above, have a CAP Membership Card and CAPF 161.
